I. INTRODUCTION

In compliance the California Public Utilities Commission ("Commission" or "CPUC")
Rules of Practice and Procedure, specifically Rule 3.2 and the terms of Decision ("D.") 07-10032, Interim Opinion on Issues Relating to Future savings Goals and Program Planning for 20092011 Energy Efficiency and Beyond; Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's
Ruling regarding 2009 to 2011 Energy Efficiency ("EE") Program Applications, February 29,
2008; Assigned Commissioner's Ruling on Revision 4.0 of the Energy Policy Manual, March 28,

2009; Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Regarding Cost-Effectiveness Metrics and Energy Efficiency Policy Manual, March 14, 2008; Joint Assigned Commissioners' Ruling Providing Guidance on Integrated Demand Side Management in 2009-2011 Portfolio Applications, April 11, 2008; Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Regarding May 15, 2008 Energy Efficiency Portfolio Plans for 2009-2011, April 21, 2008; Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Regarding Due Dates for 2009-2011 Energy Efficiency Portfolio Plans and Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan Applications, May 5, 2008; Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Resetting Date for 2009-2011 Energy Efficiency Program Applications, June 2, 2008; and Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Seeking Comment on Definition of Energy Savings Goals for 2009 Through 2011, June 2, 2008, Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Requiring Supplemental Findings dated October 30, 2008; Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Modifying Schedule and Requiring Additional Information for 2009-2011 Supplemental Filings dated December 12, 2008; Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Revising Proceeding Schedule dated February 10, 2009; and, Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge Ruling Regarding Policy Issues dated February 25, 2009 Southern California Gas Company ("SoCalGas") hereby files its Application for Natural Gas Energy Efficiency Programs for Years 2009-2011. This Amended Application replaces in its entirety SoCalGas' Application filed on July 21, 2008.

BACKGROUND AND RECOMMENDED EE POLICY CHANGES

Each of the four electric and gas utilities (Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, and SoCalGas, jointly referred

to as "the Joint IOUs")¹ regulated by the Commission propose in their EE Applications, as SoCalGas does here, the same necessary and key EE policy changes required for the success of energy efficiency in the 2009-11 period and beyond.

SoCalGas views adoption of these policy changes as essential to achieving both the Assembly Bill 32 ("AB 32") goals and the big, bold visions laid out by the Commission in D. 07-10-032. The Joint IOUs' proposal focuses on actually achieving the maximum gross energy savings to meet California's aggressive vision for energy efficiency. The IOUs request that these policy recommendations be adopted concurrent with the adoption of the each IOUs recommended portfolio.

The Joint IOUs recommend these policy changes in order to achieve a more workable system of legitimate assumptions that allow the Joint IOUs to focus on execution of their energy efficiency portfolios to support all of the state's energy efficiency goals articulated in the California Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan ("CEESP" or "Strategic Plan").

The Joint IOUs urge the Commission to adopt the recommended policy changes in order to allow for and encourage real collaboration, cooperation and innovation among all the parties that the Commission asks to join together to make energy efficiency a way of life in California. The Joint IOUs are concerned that if these policy changes are not made by the Commission, the Joint IOUs will not be able to implement energy efficiency portfolios that achieve the energy savings goals envisioned by the Strategic Plan, AB 32 Greenhouse Gas ("GHG") reduction and the Energy Action Plan ("EAP"). These policy changes, if adopted by the Commission, will reduce uncertainty and improve the overall efficiency of delivering the state's energy efficiency programs.

Specifically, the Joint IOUs request that the Commission adopt the following policy changes by ordering that:

- 1. Savings assumptions adopted for 2009-2011 Portfolio planning (ex-ante) also be used for EE portfolio evaluation providing that:
 - Savings assumptions should include limited IOU-proposed revisions to the 2008
 Database for Energy Efficiency Resources (DEER) update issued by the Energy
 Division on May 30, 2008; and
 - Evaluation studies of energy savings (ex post) will only inform future EE
 portfolio planning efforts and will not be used to reassess prior program year
 performance; and
- 2. Cumulative savings be defined as the sum of the annual savings goals for the three-year portfolio period; and
- 3. The IOUs will receive energy efficiency savings credit for energy efficiency actions taken by customers who may be motivated by state policies or legislation, local codes and ordinances, or multiple sources of "green" messaging; and
- Activities in direct support of the Strategic Plan that do not produce measurable costeffective savings in 2009-2011 will be exempt from the shareholder risk reward incentive mechanism ("RRIM"); and
- 5. Calculation of performance toward the minimum performance standard and performance earnings basis ("PEB") under the RRIM will both be based upon gross metrics since adoption of gross goals for PEB may warrant changes to the RRIM, including the shared savings rates, in order to maintain an appropriate balance of risk and reward between shareholders and customers; and

- 6. A collaborative, on-the-record process which allows for appropriate discovery, review and vetting of EE Evaluation, Measurement & Verification ("EM&V") study design, implementation and results produced by Commission staff or third parties acting for or under contract to the Commission; and
- 7. The use of a pre- or post-tax discount rate for benefits calculation.

SoCalGas understands the Assigned Commissioner and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Regarding Policy, dated February 25, 2009, concludes that of the recommended policy changes listed above, policy items 2,3,4,5 and 7 will be considered in SoCalGas' Energy Efficiency Application and that matters dealing with: (1) updates to the DEER database for the purpose of calculating incentives; (2) the ex-ante tune-up for the purpose of calculating incentives; and, (3) the exemption of codes and standards costs from the performance earnings basis will be addressed in Commission Rulemaking (R.) 09-01-019.

SoCalGas' proposed EE portfolio for 2009-2011 as developed and presented to the Commission is contingent upon the Commission adoption of all the above-described policy changes, regardless of the proceeding in which they are considered. In so stating, SoCalGas strongly recommends that any findings in any decision in this proceeding, A.08-07-022, be expressly subordinated to the outcome and findings of R.09-01-019.

The energy savings and cost effectiveness of each of the Joint IOUs' recommended portfolios are presented in each IOUs' individual testimony and tables.

SoCalGas' testimony includes results for the Mandated Scenario required to be filed pursuant to the Rulings referenced above, that employs the use of

- Cumulative goals and accounting methodologies;
- Net basis for determining PEB, and;

• Use of Energy Division-approved ex-ante DEER values for 2009-2011 Planning Purposes².

The Joint IOUs are not able to develop portfolios that adequately meet Commission adopted energy savings goals under current Commission EE policies currently in effect and mandated by the various referenced rulings.

Accordingly, if the Commission wishes to ensure that the IOUs will be able to implement portfolios that achieve the energy savings goals, the Joint IOUs urge the Commission to adopt the proposed policy changes and each Joint IOUs Preferred Scenario Energy Efficiency Portfolio.

III. SUMMARY OF APPLICATION

Pursuant to the October 30, 2008 Assigned Commissioner's and Administrative Law Judge's Ruling Requiring Supplemental Findings dated October 30, 2008 (Ruling), SoCalGas is required to file an energy efficiency portfolio application that included information set forth in the Ruling. SoCalGas has complied with this mandate. The resulting case it presents in this application, identified as the "Mandated Scenario", cannot meet goals, is only marginally cost-effective and requires a budget increase of over \$250 million. SoCalGas recommends the Commission not approve this Mandated case for reasons set forth in is testimony.

SoCalGas also presents in this application a "Preferred Scenario" Energy Efficiency portfolio encompassing all the policy changes identified by the IOUs in this proceeding. The Preferred Scenario which does meet goals, is cost effective and requires a significantly less budget increase than the Mandated Scenario. SoCalGas recommends the Commission approve its Preferred Scenario for reasons set forth in its testimony.

- SoCalGas' EE Application requests the Commission to:
- 1. Approve SoCalGas' Application which would authorize SoCalGas to implement its EE program with all recommended EE policy changes as filed; and
- 2. Approve SoCalGas' recommended change to its 2009-2011 EE goals; and
- 3. Approve SoCalGas' Preferred EE portfolio as filed; and
- 4. Not approve the Mandated EE program portfolio; and
- 5. Approve SoCalGas' recommendation that a DEER Update proceeding be established that allows for regular, transparent, fully vetted and timely update of DEER assumptions prior to the triennial update of goals and program planning and that the proceeding be timed such that it is completed by yearend prior to each year when IOU Energy Efficiency applications are required to be filed; and
- 6. Approve SoCalGas' request for funding to support SoCalGas' EE programs in the amounts of \$91,088,299 for 2009, \$91,088,299 for 2010 and \$91,088,299 for 2011; and
- 7. Approve SoCalGas' proposed cost recovery mechanism; and
- 8. Grant other such relief as the Commission deems necessary and prudent.

SoCalGas' EE Application is supported by the testimony of two witnesses. Mr. Mark Gaines, Director of Customer Programs provides SoCalGas' 2009-2011 EE Policy testimony in conjunction with the EE Policy testimony of the other California IOUs (Chapter I, Section 2) as well as an Executive Summary of SoCalGas' 2009-2011 EE Program (Chapter I, Section 1) and a description of how the Policy changes are consistent with and in support of State energy policy and the Strategic Plan (Chapter 1, Section 3). Ms. Athena Besa, Customer Program Policy and Support Manager, provides testimony concerning SoCalGas' 2009-2011 EE Programs, Goals, Portfolio, Costs and Rates (Chapter II, Sections 1 through 4).

The witnesses' prepared direct testimony is served concurrently herewith, incorporated in this Application by reference, and summarized below.

A. SoCalGas' EE Executive Summary (Chapter I, Section 1)

In Chapter I Section 1, SoCalGas witness Gaines provides, in summary form, SoCalGas' policy and purpose in filing its Application, SoCalGas' EE portfolio savings and budget, activities designed to accomplish the Big, Bold Energy Efficiency Strategies ("BBES") and strategies laid to support the California Energy Efficiency Strategic Plan, integration with its Low Income Energy Efficiency programs and strategies designed to support the CEESP.

B. SoCalGas' Proposed Energy Efficiency Policies and Rules (Chapter I, Section 2)

In Chapter I, Section 2, SoCalGas witness Gaines presents the Joint IOUs proposed necessary and key policy modifications enabling the success of energy efficiency in the 2009-2011 period and beyond. Adoption of these policies is essential to both AB 32 goal achievement and the big, bold visions laid out by the Commission in D.07-10-032. The Joint IOUs' proposal focuses on maximizing the gross energy savings necessary to meet California's aggressive vision for energy efficiency.

C. SoCalGas' EE Portfolio Reflects State and Commission Policies (Chapter I, Section 3)

In Chapter I, Section 3, SoCalGas witness Gaines discusses how SDG&E's 2009-2011 EE Application is consistent with and in support of State energy policy and Strategic Plan and how SoCalGas EE portfolios provide continued strategic planning in 2009-2011 and beyond.

D. SoCalGas' EE Program Portfolio (Chapter II, Section 1)

In Chapter II, Section 1 SoCalGas witness Besa describes SoCalGas' EE Portfolio goals and cost effectiveness. Appendices A, A.1, C, D, F and F.1 of Chapter II provide the goals and cost effectiveness details. She then describes how SoCalGas' program design achieves savings objectives. Finally Ms. Besa describes how SoCalGas' Preferred and Mandated portfolio design

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reflects market strategies, market transformation, integration, and delivery channels that enhance customer participation in demand-side resources. Appendix B of Chapter II provides the details of the program implementation plans.³

E. SoCalGas' EE Program Proposed Funding Request and Fund Shifting Proposal (Chapter II, Section 2)

In Chapter II, Section 2, SoCalGas witness Besa describes SoCalGas' proposed program portfolio funding request, and SoCalGas' proposed fund shifting guidelines for 2009-2011 and explains why these requests are reasonable. See Appendix E of Chapter II for the proposed changes to the fund shifting guidelines.

F. SoCalGas' EE Program Proposed Evaluation, Measurement and Verification (EM&V) Plans and Budgets (Chapter II, Section 3)

In Chapter II, Section 3 SoCalGas witness Besa describes SoCalGas specific EM&V plans, procedures and budgets for the years 2009-2011.

G. SoCalGas' EE Program Revenue Requirements and Cost Recovery Proposal (Chapter II, Section 4)

In Chapter II, Section 4 SoCalGas witness Besa presents, describes and justifies SoCalGas' EE program revenue requirement and cost recovery for its EE program for the years 2009-2011.

IV. STATUTORY AND PROCEDURAL REQUIREMENTS

H. Proposed Category, Issues to be Considered, Need for Hearings and Proposed Schedule

SoCalGas proposes to categorize this Application as a "rate-setting" proceeding within

However, pursuant to the February 25, 2009 Ruling reiterating the February 10, 2009 Ruling, a proposed decision on key Energy Efficiency policy issues which could materially affect the content of SoCalGas' EE filing will be issued in March 2009 well after SoCalGas' Application has been filed. It is likely that a final decision on these "Policy Issues" would then be issued thereafter. In the event this final decision on EE Policy issues impacts SoCalGas' proposed application, SoCalGas would likely be required to update its current filing.

In this event, SoCalGas proposes that the Commission provide for modification of the existing schedule in this proceeding to adequately allow for such updates.

L. Articles of Incorporation - Rule 16

SoCalGas is incorporated under the laws of the State of California. A certified copy of the restated Articles of Incorporation, as last amended, currently in effect and certified by the California Secretary of State, was filed with the Commission on October 1, 1998 in connection

with SoCalGas Application No. 98-10-012, and is incorporated herein by reference.

A general description of SoCalGas' property and equipment was previously filed with the Commission on May 3, 2004, in connection with SoCalGas' Application No. 04-05-008 and incorporated herein by reference. Appendix C to this Application is a statement of SoCalGas' Costs of Property and Depreciation Reserve applicable thereto as of September 30, 2008.

P. Summary of Earnings – Rules 3.2(a)(5)

Appendix D to this Application is a Summary of Earnings for SoCalGas for the 3 months ended September 30, 2008.

Q. Depreciation – Rule 3.2(7)

For financial statement purposes, depreciation of utility plant has been computed on a straight-line remaining life basis at rates based on the estimated useful lives of plant properties. For federal income tax accrual purposes, SoCalGas generally computes depreciation using the straight-line method for tax property additions prior to 1954, and liberalized depreciation, which includes Class Life and Asset Depreciation Range Systems, on tax property additions after 1954 and prior to 1981. For financial reporting and rate-fixing purposes, "flow through accounting" has been adopted for such properties. For tax property additions in years 1981 through 1986, SoCalGas has computed its tax depreciation using the Accelerated Cost Recovery System. For years after 1986, SoCalGas has computed its tax depreciation using the Modified Accelerated

Cost Recovery Systems and, since 1982, has normalized the effects of the depreciation differences in accordance with the Economic Recovery Tax Act of 1981 and the Tax Reform Act of 1986.

R. Proxy Statement – Rule 3.2(a)(8)

A copy of SoCalGas' most recent proxy statement, dated April 4, 2008, was mailed to the California Public Utilities Commission on April 29, 2008 and is incorporated herein by reference.

S. Pass Through of Costs – Rule 3.2(a)(10)

The changes that SoCalGas seeks in this Application reflect estimated costs to SoCalGas, and SoCalGas proposes to pass through to customers only costs that SoCalGas incurs for the services and commodities it furnishes.

T. Service and Notice – Rule 3.2(b)

SoCalGas is serving this Application on all parties to A.08-06-002, R.07-01-041, A.08-05-024, A.08-05-025, R.06-04-010, R.08-07-011, A.08-06-004, and R. 09-01-019. Within ten days of filing this application, SoCalGas will mail notice of this Application to the State of California and to cities and counties within SoCalGas' service territory and SoCalGas will post the notice in its offices and publish the notice in newspapers of general circulation in each county in its service territory. In addition, SoCalGas will include notices with the regular bills mailed to all customers affected by the proposed rate changes. The service list of state and government agencies is attached hereto as Appendix E.

V. RELIEF REQUESTED

For the reasons set forth in this Application and accompanying testimony, SoCalGas respectfully asks the Commission to:

- 1) Consider this Application and grant all the relief requested herein.
- Find that SoCalGas' proposals are in conformance with the Commission directives and policies.
- 3) Grant other such relief as the Commission may deem necessary.

WHEREFORE, SoCalGas respectfully requests the Commission grant its Application as filed.
