Maria Ventura here with SoCalGas. As we continue to work through the challenges of COVID-19, I want to share some important safety information with you and your agency. Please let me know you have received this email.
Due to COVID-19, we are still unable to meet with you in-person to provide our annual natural gas safety training. To provide your team with natural gas safety training, SoCalGas developed the attached materials covering how to safely respond to natural gas incidents and work collaboratively with SoCalGas during emergencies.
Included in the First Responders Program Materials is SoCalGas Emergency Response Video with a link to a video that was developed by SoCalGas and LA Fire that highlights our incident response to a damaged buried natural gas line. 
