### **NOTIFICATION OF REVISION TO PREVIOUSLY SENT BILL INSERT**

### **SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA GAS COMPANY NOTICE OF FILING OF LOW-INCOME PROGRAM APPLICATION NO. A.08-05-025**

*In the May and June 2008 bills, Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas®) customers received a notice of SoCalGas' Application 08-05-025, and the proposed impact on customers' average monthly bills. Please disregard this previous notice because it contained calculation errors, and refer below to the corrected information regarding the impact of Application 08-05-025 to SoCalGas customers' average monthly bills.*

On May 15, 2008, SoCalGas filed an application with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) requesting approval of a proposed funding of Program Years 2009-2011 for the Low-Income Energy Efficiency (LIEE) Program and administrative costs associated with the California Alternate Rates for Energy Program (CARE). These programs are directed at assisting qualified low-income customers with their energy bills and assisting customers to use energy more efficiently. SoCalGas requests approval to expend up to \$59.886 million, \$72.332 million and \$73.772 million for 2009, 2010 and 2011, respectively. In 2009, SoCalGas is proposing to use \$13.0 million in unspent funds to partially offset the increase in the requested expenditures, which has the net effect of reducing the 2009 dollar amount to \$46.886 million for ratemaking purposes.

If the CPUC approves the 2009-2011 LIEE and CARE proposed budgets net of the use of the unspent funds for 2009, SoCalGas will adjust rates to reflect authorization of increased costs. Gas rates will increase by \$8.961 million in

2009, by \$34.407 million in 2010 and by \$35.847 million in 2011, compared to present rates to fully fund the 2009-2011 programs authorized by the CPUC. SoCalGas requests that the proposed gas rate and revenue requirement increase become effective on January 1, 2009, or as soon as possible after this requested date.

The tables below show the 2009-2011 gas rate impacts compared to present rates for only the proposed Public Purpose Program (PPP) surcharge portion of the total bill.

*The average monthly residential bill of 46 therms will change from \$62.22 at present rates to \$62.53 in 2009, \$62.99 in 2010 and \$63.01 in 2011, respectively. This represents a 1.3% increase over the three-year program period.*

**THE CPUC MAY HOLD EVIDENTIARY HEARINGS**

The CPUC may hold evidentiary hearings at which the parties of record provide testimony and are subject to cross examination before an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). After considering all of the evidence presented, the Commission will issue a decision. The Commission may approve expenditures that differ from those we request. The actual rates may result in changes greater or less than those described in this notice.
