Privilege Log

In accordance with ALJ Long’s May 22, 2007 Ruling, Applicants are providing a privilege log for SDG&E’s and SoCalGas’ data request responses to date in their 2008 General Rate Case, A.06-12-009 and A.06-12-010. In addition, set forth immediately below is a “waived” privilege log, i.e. a listing of documents for which this privilege is being waived.

I. Log of Documents for which the Attorney-Client Privilege is Waived

The bulk of the entries in the table below are with respect to the “Utility of the Future” documents provided in response to UCAN-11, Question 15. Applicants note that the documents which were previously withheld in their response to that data request have recently been provided to UCAN and other intervenors who requested them. Upon further review Applicants have waived the attorney client privilege with respect to these documents in the interest of allowing a full record to be developed in the GRC proceeding. Applicants are also releasing any claim of confidentiality on the documents below, with one exception, the Tech 20/20 document dated 12/06, which is marked confidential and is ‘Protected Material’ pursuant to the Protective Order in this proceeding.

The last two documents on this list were previously withheld from Applicant’s response to TURN 23, question 11. TURN Data Request No. 23, Question 11 requested documents related to “rate impacts.” Applicants responded with eight documents and withheld (based on attorney-client privilege) two documents which are unrelated to the “Utility of the Future” program. Upon further review Applicants have waived the

attorney client privilege with respect to these two documents in the interest of allowing a full record to be developed in the GRC proceeding and have recently provided copies of these documents to TURN. One of these two documents (dated 6/28/06) is marked confidential, 'Protected Material' pursuant to the Protective Order ("PO") in this proceeding.

The waiver of attorney client privilege with respect to the documents identified above should not be interpreted as a waiver in this proceeding pertaining to any other privileged documents withheld, or potentially to be withheld in the future.
