SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Report of Exempt Quantities:

- a. An electric generator that sells all or only a portion of its electricity production wholesale to an electric, gas, or steam public utility or the California Independent System Operator must provide a written report (Report of Exemption from SRF, Form No. _____) of the exempt gas quantities to the utility within 3 business days following the month in which gas was consumed in order to receive the exemption. If all gas quantities that are delivered to the electric generator will be exempt on a continuing basis, the electric generator may provide a prospectively effective Report of Exemption with a duration that shall not exceed twelve (12) calendar months.
- b. Customer is responsible for the accuracy of its reported exempt quantities.
