Subject: Expedited Advice Letter Approval for El Paso Natural Gas Company Pipeline Capacity Contract Renewal – Decision (D.) 04-09-022

Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) respectfully requests California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) authorization to renew for one year an interstate pipeline transportation contract on El Paso Natural Gas Company (EPNG).

Purpose

The purpose of this expedited advice letter is to request approval by the Commission to renew for a one-year term an existing interstate capacity transportation contract on EPNG. This contract is used to transport natural gas supplies from the San Juan basin to California on behalf of SoCalGas' core gas procurement customers.

Background

D.04-09-022 was issued, in part, to address the Phase I proposal of SoCalGas, filed in compliance with R.04-01-025, on new capacity contracting procedures that allowed for the utility to acquire core capacity in a more efficient and cost effective manner. The Commission approved procedures for capacity contract approval that rely on consultation between SoCalGas, Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA), The Utility Reform Network (TURN), and the Energy Division for all commitments for interstate capacity.

Under the interstate capacity acquisition procedure approved in D.04-09-022, contracts for interstate capacity supported by DRA and TURN may be submitted for expedited advice letter approval to the Commission. DRA and TURN have authorized SoCalGas to state that they support this one-year renewal request for the EPNG contract.

Description of Contract

SoCalGas requests a one-year renewal of an EPNG contract for 25,138 Dth/d from April 1, 2009 to March 31, 2010. This contract is at EPNG's maximum tariff rates. Effective January 1, 2009, the monthly reservation rate is expected to be \$12.1128 per Dth and the daily volumetric commodity rate is \$.0275 Dth/d. These rates are EPNG's after management adjustment rates and are subject to refund in EPNG's Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) General Rate Case Docket No. RP08-426-000. This contract has Right of First Refusal (ROFR). Due to EPNG's posting requirements, SoCalGas requests the Commission approve this Expedited Advice Letter as promptly as possible.

Protest: Ten-Day Expedited Period

Anyone wishing to protest this Expedited Advice Letter may do so by sending a letter to the address below. The protest must state the grounds upon which it is based, including such items as financial and service impact, and should be submitted expeditiously. The protest must be made in writing and received within 10 days of the date this Expedited Advice Letter was filed with the Commission.
