18 The parties have met and conferred regarding Plaintiff's *Ex Parte* Application For
19 Temporary Restraining Order and Order to Show Cause Regarding Preliminary Injunction and
20 have agreed as follows:

21 1. Southern California Gas Company ("SoCalGas") agrees to implement the SS-25
22 Incident Aliso Canyon Gas Leak Odorous Emissions Mitigation Plan and Temporary Relocation
23 Plan dated December 15, 2015, the final version of which was distributed December 22, 2015,
24 and as amended herein, attached as Exhibit A (the "Plan").

25 2. SoCalGas will pay reasonable costs of boarding pets of Porter Ranch residents if
26 the resident believes those pets are experiencing symptoms from the natural gas leak at Aliso
27 Canyon.

28 3. SoCalGas will pay for any additional overtime and costs associated with extra Los

1 Angeles Police Department (“LAPD”) security patrols in the Porter Ranch area that may be
2 recommended by the LAPD.

3 4. The parties will immediately meet and confer in good faith to select one or more
4 retired judges, paid for by SoCalGas, who will act as mediators to promptly resolve disputes
5 between individuals who are requesting relocation or other services under the Plan and SoCalGas
6 regarding the individual’s request (“Disputes”). The interests of people with special needs will
7 be primary in the processing of Disputes. The parties shall meet and confer regarding the
8 specific procedures the mediator(s) and parties shall follow in the mediation process.


9 5. If the mediator is unable to resolve a Dispute, the mediator shall notify counsel
10 for the parties who shall, within 48 hours, meet and confer to attempt to resolve the Dispute.

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
1 6. If counsel for the parties are unable to resolve the Dispute, the Plaintiffs shall


