SURCHARGE TO FUND PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION MASTER METERED MOBILE HOME PARK GAS SAFETY INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM

APPLICABILITY

This surcharge applies to all master metered mobile home parks receiving service under Rate Schedule Nos. GS, GSL, and GM. The surcharge shall apply to each space whether or not a structure is in place.

TERRITORY

Applicable throughout the system.

RATES

Surcharge*

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- 1. Notification: It is the responsibility of the mobile home park operator to advise the Utility within 15 days following any change in the number of mobile home spaces served with natural gas.
- 2. Surcharge Recovery: Under Section 4358(c) of the Public Utilities Code, the mobile home park owner or operator is allowed by law to recover the surcharge from tenants on a monthly basis. The surcharge to any tenant shall not exceed the lesser of 25¢ per month or the Public Utility Commission's most recently established surcharge: 21¢ per space per month beginning July 1, 2000, until further Order of the Commission.
