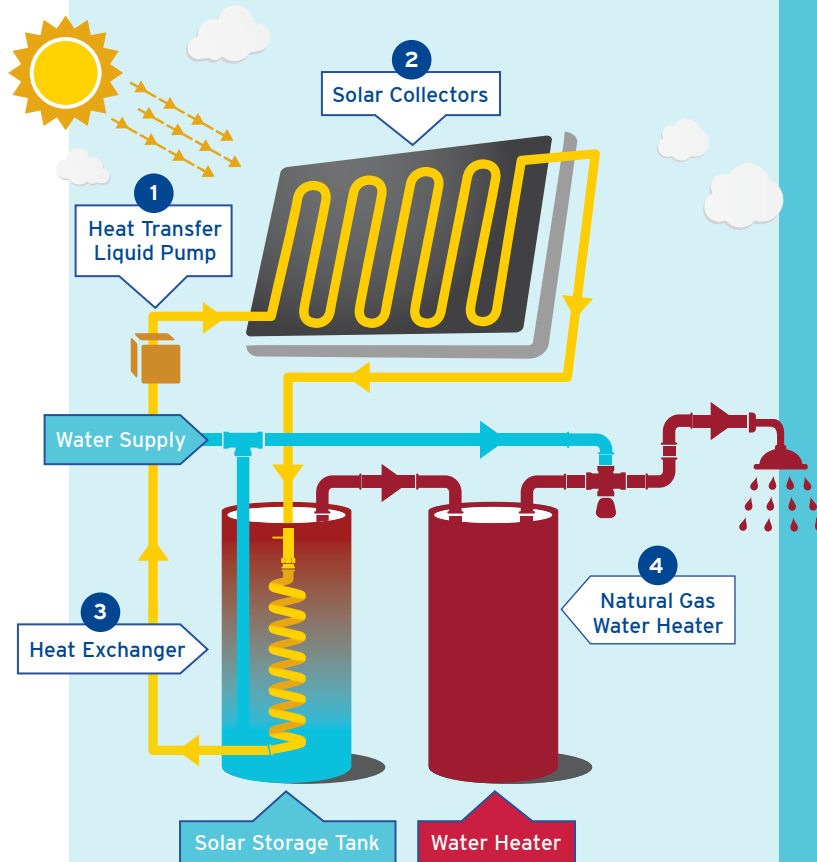

HOW DOES SOLAR WATER HEATING WORK?

1. A pump circulates a heat transfer liquid to the roof.
2. Solar collectors absorb the sun's thermal energy and heat the transfer liquid.
3. The transfer liquid enters a heat exchanger, warming the storage tank.
4. Hot water flows from the storage tank to your existing natural gas water heater, which provides backup heating when needed.



WORKS DAY OR NIGHT, RAIN OR SHINE.

A solar water heating system captures the warmth of the sun and uses it to heat water for your home. On clear days, the system heats water with the sun and stores it until needed.

On cloudy days and at night, the system works with your existing natural gas water heater so that your family has their usual available hot water, seven days a week.

WHY HEAT WATER WITH THE SUN?

- Capture clean energy from the sun
- Use less natural gas for heating water
- May save on your monthly utility bill
- Reduce your family's carbon footprint
- Make your home more sustainable

HOW MUCH ARE THE SOLAR WATER HEATING REBATES?

SoCalGas® customers may be eligible for a rebate of up to \$4,366 for installing solar water heating. Income-qualified customers may be eligible for an increased rebate amount of up to \$5,397.

When you install a qualifying solar water heating system, you may also qualify for federal and local tax credits that cover a portion of the installed equipment costs.¹

The final rebate is calculated based on estimated annual energy savings as well as household income.

Rebate amounts are valid through December 31, 2018 while funds are available.

The CSI-Thermal Program offers rebates to single-family homeowners who:

- Currently heat water with natural gas
