INTERNSHIP DETAILS

Interns at SoCalGas are given various opportunities to learn alongside professionals. The work that they do directly correlates with our operations which include:

- Create presentation decks, develop agendas and content and collaborate with colleagues.
- Cross-collaborate with multiple different teams to support customer energy efficiency program implementation.
- Forecast budgets which could be utilized across the department.
- Interact with specialized software to gain in-depth knowledge on different tools and functions.
- Track workbook confirmations every month from program managers and follow up on corrections.
- Track projects and provide analysis using PowerBI and other data visualizations software.
- Develop dashboards to track key performance indicators (KPI's), budget, and energy savings information.
- Increase visibility across Customer Programs and Assistance so that applicable stakeholders are aware of whether compliance is satisfied/on-track.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be enrolled in a college or university business administration program, other disciplines will be considered.
- 3.0 cumulative GPA or above is required.
- Be able to work 30-40 hours per week in the summer (12 weeks).
- Must be legally authorized to work in the United States on an ongoing basis without company sponsorship.
