Please explain the basis for the negative 106,823 shown for the proposed value of the “EG Transmission Level Service – GHG End User Fee” in column I of line 28 of the Table 6 on the tab “Rate Tables” in the SCG Rate Design Model\_2027 CAP.xlsx. The corresponding “EG Transmission Level Service – GHG End User Fee” value for present rates, shown at line 28 column F, is 122,273. Why would the value have both diminished and gone from a positive value to a negative value?
