WHAT IS BEING REQUESTED?

Natural gas purchases are reviewed under the GCIM which incentivizes utilities to secure lower prices, share savings with customers and shareholders, and absorb part of any higher costs, with savings benefiting SoCalGas Core customers. In the latest GCIM year, SoCalGas purchased natural gas at \$46.4 million below the target price during the program period of April 1, 2025, to March 31, 2026. SoCalGas is requesting approval to allocate approximate \$9.0 million of that for its shareholders whilst proving \$37.4 million in lower gas costs to its customers.

HOW WOULD THIS IMPACT THE AVERAGE RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER?

If the request is approved, there will be no additional change in customer rates from this application. A typical residential customer's average monthly bill for 35 therms of gas has already increased by 0.09 cents/month, from \$71.98 to \$72.07. A typical residential customer's monthly summer bill for 23 therms of gas has already increased by 0.06 cents/month, from \$49.78 to \$49.83. If the CPUC approves a different allocation for SoCalGas shareholders, the difference will be credited or charged to customers through a rate change in future months.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

An administrative law judge will hold hearings, consider evidence, testimony, and public comments before drafting a proposed decision on this application. CPUC Commissioners will then vote on a final decision at a public meeting.
