Regional Public Affairs (RPA) provides essential local government and community liaison functions consistent with CPUC recognition for the need for utility engagement to support safe, reliable, and cost-effective service. RPA manages ongoing relationships with local governments and stakeholders, supports safety and emergency response coordination, responds to operational and customer issues, and facilitates required notifications and safety education. RPA also advances customer affordability through targeted outreach on Commission-approved assistance and clean energy programs, supports compliance and cost control by facilitating local permitting and managing franchise agreements, and implements Commission-directed stakeholder engagement activities, including public participation hearings and community meetings.

Forecast Explanations:

Labor - Base YR Rec

Labor costs are forecasted using the Base Year methodology based on 2025 actual expenditures. The forecast includes labor costs as well as incremental funding for additional FTEs to support increased operational demands, compliance requirements, and CPUC-mandated stakeholder engagement activities.

Non-Labor - Base YR Rec

Non-labor (NL) costs are forecasted using the Base Year methodology based on 2025 actual expenditures. The forecast includes ongoing NL costs as well as incremental adjustments for travel, equipment, onboarding, and vendor support for Climate Adaptation and Vulnerability Assessment (CAVA) activities. These activities include stakeholder engagement, outreach, and participation by Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) and Tribal governments.
