

The Refinery Gas Energy Efficiency Program (RGEEP) is available to eligible SoCalGas refinery customers within the SoCalGas service territory. The RGEEP is designed to deliver comprehensive and sustained energy savings through downstream energy and operational savings while helping build a culture to support energy management excellence within the organization focused on operational efficiency.

Technical Engineering Services Offered

The RGEEP includes the following engineering services:

- Comprehensive audit and energy efficiency improvement (EEI) screening
- Customer education
- Energy modeling
- Business case development
- Facility benchmarking
- Equipment identification
- Financing support

Scope of Comprehensive Audit and EEI Screening

Scope of Service for comprehensive audits and EEI screening may include, but are not limited to:

- Steam system pipe insulation
- Condensate return systems
- Turbine installation/economics
- Steam trap survey and repair/replacement
- Process steam uses
- Process controls
- Heat exchangers and end use survey
- Flash steam heat recovery
- Clean steam systems
- Humidification systems
- HVAC systems
- Boiler systems and controls
- Waste heat recovery
- Steam or engine driven compressor equipment

Willdan Energy Solutions ("Willdan") is a SoCalGas authorized contractor responsible for implementing this program through 12/31/2027.

Analysis and reporting are vendor neutral. Eligible customers are able to pursue projects using internal resources or the contractor of their choice for installation of EELs. There is no requirement to work with any preferred vendor(s) nor is there a requirement to install any EELs identified during the audit.

Program Eligibility Requirements

The RGEEP is open to refinery customers who meet the following criteria:

- Have an active SoCalGas account.
- Are defined as refineries by their North American Industry Classification System code – NAICS 32.
- Pay the Public Purpose Program (PPP) surcharge on the account where the EEL is to be installed.
- Have no outstanding late payments on their SoCalGas bill.
- Are not applying to more than one California energy efficiency incentive or rebate program for the same EEL.
- Have not received incentives for the same EEL within the last five (5) years.

The RGEEP accepts a wide variety of refinery energy-savings projects. EEL eligibility will be made at the discretion of the Program on a per-site basis; however, all EELs must meet the following criteria:

- Exceed baseline energy performance (results in energy savings).
- Must operate at least five (5) years or for the life of the incentivized EEL.
- Be permanently installed.
- Cannot overlap with other incentive programs.
- Existing equipment replaced is decommissioned and removed from the site.

Step 2: Project Planning	• Project site visit • Energy audit • Submetering • Incentive application development • Project feasibility study submittal to utility • Utility project incentive approval • Complete, sign, and submit the RGEEP Conditional Incentive Reservation Form
Step 3: Construction and Completion	• Design assistance • Project construction • Project measurement & verification • Utility confirms project completion • Payment of incentive based on actual measured EEL savings
