Independent Accountant's Report on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures

**To the Board of Directors of

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the management of the San Diego Gas & Electric Company ("SDG&E") and the Southern California Gas Company ("SoCalGas") (collectively, the "Companies"), solely to assist the management of the Companies in evaluating the compliance of the 2020 Tables (the 2020 Tables are included in the Companies' General Order No. 77-M 2020 Annual Report and consist of the Companies' Executive Officers and Employees with a Base Salary of \$250,000 or More Per Annum and Executive Officers of the Utility's Holding Company Summary of Compensation Table, 2020 Options Exercised and Stock Vested Table, 2020 Change in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest Table, and 2020 All Other Compensation Table) with subsections (a) and (c) of the California Public Utilities Commission's (the "CPUC's") General Order No. 77-M ("GO No. 77-M"). The Companies' management is responsible for the Companies' compliance with those requirements. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of the Companies' management. Consequently, we make no representations regarding the sufficiency of the procedures enumerated below either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures performed were not intended to address legal issues as to whether an item is required to be disclosed nor are they designed to address compensation disclosures required by GO No. 77-M subsections other than subsections (a) and (c).

For purposes of performing these agreed-upon procedures, no exceptions were reported for differences of \$1,000 or less resulting solely from the rounding of amounts disclosed.



The following procedures performed in relation to the 2020 Tables and results thereof are as follows:

I. Executive Officers and Employees with a Base Salary of \$250,000 or More per Annum and Executive Officers of the Utility's Holding Company Summary of Compensation Table (Summary of Compensation Table)

Procedures Performed:

A. Column headed "Name" and "Title"

1. We agreed the "Name" of the Executive Officers of SDG&E and/or SoCalGas listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to a report extracted from Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM system identifying employees with a 2020 base salary of \$250,000 or more. For retired officers, we agreed the individual's name to Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM System.
2. We agreed the "Name" and "Title" of the Executive Officers of SDG&E and/or SoCalGas listed in the respective columns per the Summary of Compensation Table to the "Sempra Energy Annual Report". For non-officers and retired officers not included in the Sempra Energy Annual Report, we agreed the individual's "Name" and "Title" to the ADP Vantage HCM system.
3. We agreed the "Name" and "Title" of the named Executive Officers of Sempra Energy Corporate listed in the respective columns per the Summary of Compensation Table to Sempra Energy's Notice of 2021 Annual Meeting of Shareholders and Proxy Statement. See results below:

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying these procedures.

B. Column headed "Base Salary (\$)"

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the "Base Salary (\$)" column for each of the Executive Officers listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to the Compensation History - by EE ID report extracted from Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM system. For retired officers, we agreed the respective individual's base salary listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM system. Amounts reported under the column headed "Base Salary (\$)" did not include payouts of accrued time off balances in connection with retirements and terminations.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.



C. Column headed "Bonus"

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the "Bonus" column for each of the Executive Officers listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to the 2020 Executive W-2 Summaries Report extracted from Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

D. Column headed "Non-Equity Incentive Plan Compensation (\$)"

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the "Non-Equity Incentive Plan Compensation (\$)" column for each of the Executive Officers listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to a report generated from Sempra Energy's ADP Vantage HCM system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

E. Column headed "Stock Awards (\$)"

1. We agreed the date and quantity of performance-based and time-based restricted stock units granted in 2020 for each officer and non-officer listed in the respective columns per the Summary of Compensation Table to the Options and Awards Granted report generated from Sempra Energy's E-Trade Equity Edge system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

F. Column headed "Change in Pension Value and Nonqualified Deferred Compensation Earnings (\$)"

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the "Change in Pension Value and Nonqualified Deferred Compensation Earnings (\$)" column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to the total in the "2020 Change in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest for the Year Ended December 31, 2020" table located on page 3 of Section Titled: Executive Officers and Employees with a Base Salary of \$250,000 or More Per Annum and Executive Officers of the Utility's Holding Company.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

G. Column headed "All Other Compensation (\$)"

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the "All Other Compensation (\$)" column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the Summary of Compensation Table to the total in the "2020 All Other Compensation" table located on page 4 of Section Titled: Executive Officers and Employees with a Base Salary of \$250,000 or More Per Annum and Executive Officers of the Utility's Holding Company.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.



H. Column headed "Allocation"

1. We did not perform any procedures on the column headed "Allocation".

II. 2020 Options Exercised and Stock Vested Table

Procedures Performed:

A. Column headed "Option Awards (Service-Based Stock Options)"

1. We agreed the "Number of Shares Acquired on Exercise" and the "Value Realized on Exercise" for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 Options Exercised and Stock Vested Table to the Confirmation of Exercise reported from Sempra Energy's E-Trade Equity Edge system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

B. Column headed "Stock Awards (Performance-Based Restricted Stock)"

1. We agreed the "Number of Shares Acquired on Vesting" and the "Value Realized on Vesting" for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 Options Exercised and Stock Vested Table to the 1) Statement of Taxable Income report for 2020 generated from Sempra Energy's E-Trade Equity Edge system; and 2) the 2020 Trailing Dividend Calc report.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

III. 2020 Change in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest Table

Procedures Performed:

A. Column headed "Change in Accumulated Benefits (\$)"

1. We agreed the amount shown in the "Change in Accumulated Benefits (\$)" column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 Change in Pension value and Above-Market Interest Table to column H of the Summary Compensation Table exhibit prepared by Willis Towers Watson, Sempra Energy's actuary and to the footnote disclosures of the Summary Compensation Table, when applicable.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.



B. Column headed “Above-Market Interest (\$)”

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the “Above-Market Interest (\$)” column for each officer listed in the 2020 Change in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest Table who earned above-market interest to the 2020 Excess Interest report.
2. We agreed the sum of the “Change in Accumulated Benefits (\$)” column and the “Above-Market Interest” column for each officer listed in the 2020 Change in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest Table to the “Total” column per the table.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying these procedures.

IV. 2020 All Other Compensation Table

Procedures Performed:

A. Column headed “Company 401(k) and Related Plan Contributions (\$)”

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the “Company 401(k) and Deferred Compensation Plan Contributions (\$)” column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 All Other Compensation Table to the totals shown for Match and Excess Match on the 2020 Deferrals per reports extracted from Sempra Energy’s ADP Vantage HCM system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

B. Column headed “Insurance Premiums (\$)”

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the “Insurance Premiums (\$)” column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 All Other Compensation Table to the amounts shown on the 2020 W-2 Summary Report extracted from Sempra Energy’s ADP Vantage HCM system for personal liability insurance and executive life insurance unless such benefits were covered under the executive benefit program allowance. We agreed the amounts shown for executive medical, Medjet, and individual supplemental disability insurance to the executive medical premium schedule provided by management, the Medjet Membership Renewal Report, and the Met Life Supplemental Disability invoice.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.



C. Column headed “Other Benefits (\$)”

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the “Other Benefits (\$)” column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 All Other Compensation Table to the amounts shown for financial planning, executive benefit program allowance, and tax gross-ups on the 2020 Exec W-2 Summaries Report extracted from Sempra Energy’s ADP Vantage HCM system. We agreed the amounts for personal use of company cars, drivers and corporate airplane, non-cash gifts, residential security, severance, and charitable matching contributions shown to the list of executives for whom these items are applicable. Amounts reported under the “Other Benefits” column did not include estimates of costs for benefits provided to retired executives following their retirements or relocation costs for employees who relocated at the Companies’ request and, to avoid duplication, did not include amounts paid under the executive benefits program allowance.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.

D. Column headed “Health & Welfare Benefits (\$)”

1. We agreed the amounts shown in the “Health & Welfare Benefits (\$)” column for each of the Executive Officers and Employees listed in the 2020 All Other Compensation Table to the amounts shown for company flexible benefits contributions on the 2020_Co_Cost_for_Benefits_for_GO-77_Filing extracted from Sempra Energy’s ADP Vantage HCM system.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying this procedure.



V. 2020 Tables

Procedures Performed:

We recalculated the mathematical accuracy of the following tables:

- A. Summary of Compensation Table, with the exception of the three columns listed under the "Allocation" column, for which we did not perform any procedures.
- B. 2020 Options Exercised and Stock Vested Table
- C. 2020 Changes in Pension Value and Above-Market Interest Table
- D. 2020 All Other Compensation Table.

No exceptions were noted as a result of applying these procedures.

This narrative statement and the amounts reported herein generally follow the presentation included in the Sempra Energy proxy statement and Southern California Gas Company information statement prepared for their annual meetings of shareholders held on May 14, 2021 and June 1, 2021, respectively.

1. Base Salaries

The executive compensation programs of Southern California Gas Company, San Diego Gas & Electric and Sempra Energy emphasize performance-based annual bonuses and equity-based long-term incentive awards. However, base salaries remain a necessary and standard part of compensation for attracting and retaining outstanding employees at all levels.

Base salaries for executive officers are targeted at the median of those for the Fortune 500 companies with revenues between \$6.25 billion and \$25 billion ("general industry peer group"). Using national general industry comparisons helps attract and retain top-quality executive talent from a broad range of backgrounds.

Base salaries for executive officers are reviewed annually and the following factors are considered:

2. Performance-Based Annual Bonuses

Each year, performance guidelines are established for annual bonuses. Consistent with the pay-for-performance philosophy, the guidelines do not provide for any bonus payment unless the threshold (minimum) performance level is attained. Bonus opportunities increase for performance above the threshold level. For a detailed description of individual bonus opportunities, performance measures and 2020 results, please refer to pages 54-57 and 105-107 of the Sempra Energy proxy statement and pages 16-19 of the SoCalGas information statement.

Potential bonuses at threshold, target and maximum company performance are expressed as a percentage of each executive officer's base salary. The target bonus potentials and percentages are consistent with the leverage typically found in bonus plans within general industry. Extraordinary company or individual performance may result in the payment of bonuses above the guidelines.

3. Long Term Equity-Based Incentives

Long term equity-based incentives are the largest single component of each executive officer's compensation package. In 2020, the long-term incentive plan award was in the form of performance-based and time-based Sempra Energy restricted stock units. This award structure was determined after considering many variables. These included alignment with shareholder interests, retention, plan expense, share usage, market trends, and feedback from Sempra Energy's shareholder outreach.

Performance-based restricted stock units:

Each annual performance-based restricted stock unit granted in 2020 represents the right to receive between zero and 2.0 shares of Sempra Energy common stock. The 2020 annual performance-based restricted stock unit awards are based on two performance measures – relative total shareholder return and earnings per share growth.

Time-based restricted stock units:

Time-based restricted stock units granted in 2020 vest in equal installments of one-third over a 3-year period, subject to continued employment through each vesting date. The primary purpose of these awards is to promote retention.

For a detailed description of the 2020 awards and the results for the 2018-2020 award cycle, please refer to pages 57-61 of the Sempra Energy proxy statement and pages 20-23 of the SoCalGas information statement.

Benefit Plans

Executive officers also participate in other benefit programs including: 1) Health, Life Insurance and Disability Plans, and Other Benefits; 2) Retirement Plans; and 3) Savings and Deferred Compensation Plans. These benefits are described on pages 62-64 of the Sempra Energy proxy statement and pages 23-26 of the SoCalGas Information Statement.

Regular Employee Benefits

The SEC's proxy rules, for the most part, do not require reporting of broad-based employee benefit plans such as those providing medical, dental, life or disability coverage. However, amounts related to broad-based pension benefits and the 401(k) savings plan are discussed in the Compensation Discussion and Analysis and reported in the executive compensation tables.

The companies' flexible benefits plan allows employees to select the types and levels of benefits that best meet their needs and those of their families. Benefit options include:

- Medical plans (choice of HMO's and a high-deductible health plan)
- Dental plans (choice of Delta Dental plan and dental HMO)
- Long-term disability coverage
- Life insurance
- Accident insurance
- Healthcare, Dependent day care and Transportation flexible spending accounts

Each benefit option has a price tag reflecting the employee's cost for coverage. The amounts shown in the Regular Benefits column of the All Other Compensation table in this report reflect the portion of the benefit costs paid by the companies.

In addition to the flexible benefit plan, the companies also provide short-term counseling and referral services under the employee assistance plans and various wellness programs.

SOCALGAS COMPANY PROPORTION OF COMPENSATION PAID DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY BY UTILITY CUSTOMERS FOR THE YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2020

In Decision (D.) 19-09-051, modified by D.20-07-038 (Rehearing Decision), the California Public Utilities Commission resolved San Diego Gas & Electric Company's (SDG&E's)/Southern California Gas Company's (SoCalGas') 2019 General Rate Case ("2019 GRC"), authorizing SoCalGas to recover the portion of 2020 forecast costs to be paid by customers as set forth below.

- **Executive Officers:** no compensation and benefits costs for "executive officers" as defined in Resolution E-4963 ("Executive Officers");
- **Base Salaries:** all of the forecast costs for salaries for employees of SoCalGas who are not Executive Officers;
- **Spot Cash and Employee Recognition ("Bonus" column in schedule):** 69% for SoCalGas of the forecast costs for spot cash and employee recognition, collectively;
- **ICP/Variable Pay (Non-Equity Incentive Plan Compensation column in schedule):**
 - None of the forecast costs for Executive ICP (covering both Executive Officers and other officers);
 - 90% for SoCalGas of the forecast costs for Non-Executive ICP;
- **Long-Term Incentive Plan, or LTIP ("Stock Awards and Option Awards" columns in schedule):** None of the forecast costs for LTIP;
- **Pension:**
 - all of the forecast costs for qualified pension for employees who are not Executive Officers;
 - 50% of the forecast costs for nonqualified pension and nonqualified savings plan for employees who are not Executive Officers;
- **All Other Compensation:**
 - all of the forecast costs for the qualified 401(k) retirement savings plan for employees who are not Executive Officers;
 - none of the costs for certain other executive benefits, such as financial planning, which were not requested in the 2019 GRC; and
 - all of the forecast costs for health and welfare benefits for employees who are not Executive Officers.

A portion of the forecast compensation and benefit cost for executive officers of Sempra Energy are allocated to SDG&E/SoCalGas (excluding the Chairman and CEO of Sempra Energy and Group President of Sempra Energy whose costs are not allocated). The 2019 GRC provided funding for the forecast costs for allocations of salary and benefit costs but did not provide funding for cost allocations related to ICP and LTIP for executive officers of Sempra Energy.
