SoCalGas has received some fairly large Data Requests from the City of Ventura. To respond to some questions related to air quality we need to reference some of the updated attachments that were part of SoCalGas' *Response to PEA Completeness Review, September 2023 (Response)*. We normally do not post environmental related documents on our public SoCalGas Regulatory Proceeding Webpage ([ventura-compressor-modernization](#)). If environmental related documents are needed to be referenced outside of the application and PEA on our SoCalGas webpage, we would reference the documents posted on the CPUC CEQA Webpage.

We noticed that the CPUC CEQA Webpage for the Project is not yet operational where normally the deficiency letter and *Responses* are posted.
